Monitoring Required by SFA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pre-operational monitoring visits • First week monitoring visits • First four weeks of operation visits 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Single review within four weeks of start of operations
Monitoring Required by ADE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Subject to review by ADE <i>at least</i> once every three years (may be more frequent based on program size and prior problems identified by ADE) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review summer prior to CRE every five years
Types and Eligibility of Sites	<p><u>Open or Restricted-Open</u> – based on 50% F/RP enrollment of the attendance area of a school or census block-group data. Meals served free. Open to community.</p> <p><u>Closed enrolled</u> – 50% of children enrolled in needy or non-needy areas and are eligible for F/RP benefits.</p>	Same as Simplified SFSP: Open, Restricted Open, or Closed Enrolled sites are eligible for the waiver.
Meal Counting	At point of service, first and 2% of seconds	At point of service, one meal type per child per day
Training	Required for all new sponsors and/or staff or as needed	Required for new sponsors
Site Change Reporting	Report and get prior approval for site changes and field trips	Report any changes to ADE

Public Notification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sponsor is required to send public media notice regarding program and eligibility 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No public notification required but Sponsor must advertise sites to community
Claiming	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meals x Rates 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Same as NSLP
Miscellaneous	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SFSP meals served did not count toward SNB and 2-cent differential • Meal caps for new programs and FSMC required 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eligible free lunches served during summer month's count towards SNB and 2-cent differential. • Meal Caps not required
