This memorandum is a follow up to CN #02-10 regarding Pandemic Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (P-SNAP) benefits for children certified as eligible to receive free & reduced-price school lunch during school closures. At this time, the Arizona Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, formerly the Food Stamp Program) agency has determined not to exercise this authority and will not implement P-SNAP benefits during a pandemic emergency.

LEAs with children in these circumstances may be eligible for meals provided through the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) H1N1 waiver. For information regarding the SFSP H1N1 waiver, reference CN 08-10, SFSP 04-09 "School Closures during a H1N1 Outbreak" and CN 20-10, SFSP 07-09 "Additional Q&A for School Closures Due to H1N1 Outbreaks."
